




Figure 2 – How do you rate the content of the course?




Figure 3 – How do you rate the content of the course?






Figure 4 – The lecturer gives helpful feedback on contributions from students.








Figure 5 – Which teaching formats do you find particularly effective in online teaching?






Figure 6 – Which teaching formats do you find particularly effective in online teaching?




Figure 7 – How do you rate the technical conditions for online teaching?




Figure 8 – How do you rate the technical conditions for online teaching?




Figure 9 – The lecturer is easily accessible for questions:




Figure ${\bf 10}$ – The lecturer is easily accessible for questions:




Figure 11 – How do you rate your knowledge acquisition?





Figure 12 – How do you rate your knowledge acquisition?






Figure 13 – How often have you participated in this module?




Figure 14 – The lecturer provided clear information about the examination process:





Figure 15 – The lecturer provided clear information about the examination process:


